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Go-GRID is a comprehensive learning program designed by Sudridh-NURP for the young professionals working with public, private or development organizations in the fields of community infrastructure development, heritage preservation, gender and social inclusion, environment, transportation and mobility, governance and social development at the local levels.

Go-GRID learning aims at developing human centered design through design thinking bootcamp approach to make the urban designs more acceptable to the community, user-friendly, compatible to the environment and sustainable in the long run.

Applicants should have completed bachelor degree in civil engineering, architecture, economics, science, social or business development, environment, law or any development related subjects. Applicants should have at least one year of experience in local level planning and development in the form of design, advocacy, community mobilization, local administration or management. Applicants should be residing in or around Pokhara, Butwal or Janakpurdham Municipalities.





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Go-GRID objectives:

- To develop shared understanding on design issues that adversely impact cost-effectiveness, lifecycle, inclusion, resilience and resource efficiency
- To promote design thinking in asset providers and managers in the municipality for resilient, inclusive and green design.
- To ensure these design ideas are replicable and scalable across the municipality.
- To highlight inter-disciplinary/inter-agency collaboration required for developing and delivering design ideas.

Go-GRID learning modality has been designed "Hybrid", with several on-line sessions and two workshops spread across a span of four months. At the end of the programme, the participants will learn, understand and obtain practical knowledge about the design process for green, resilient and inclusive infrastructure development. The entire process will be facilitated by experienced national and international professionals.

Go-GRID learning programme will be conducted in Pokhara Metropolitan City, Butwal and Janakpurdham Sub-Metropolitan Cities from November 2022 to February 2023. There will be 16 participants from each city.

The applicant:

- should have completed bachelor degree in civil engineering, architecture, economics, science, social or business development, environment, law or any development related subjects.
- should have at least one year of experience in local level planning and development in the form of design, advocacy, community mobilization, local administration or management.
- should be residing in or around Pokhara, Butwal or Janakpurdham municipalities.

Participation Fee: Rs. 2000/- per person, refundable at the completion of the programme.
